

Egypt Tour Itinerary. What is an Egyptologist.

An Egyptologist is any archaeologist, historian, linguist, or art historian who specializes in Egyptology, the scientific study of Ancient Egypt and its antiquities. Demotists are Egyptologists who specialize in the study of the Demotic language and field of Demotic Studies. A visa is needed for Egypt – cost USD \$25 –payable at the airport.

Day 1 –Cairo

Upon arrival in Cairo, you will be met by **our travel** representative in Egypt and transferred to your hotel for overnight.

Day 2 –Cairo (Pyramids, Museum)

After breakfast your private Egyptologist tour guide and driver will pick you up and start your tour. Drive to Giza and visit the Pyramids. Visit the Egyptian Museum; this houses a magnificent collection of Pharaonic antiquities, especially the golden treasures of Tut Ankh Amun. Transfer to the train station for your departure to Luxor. 
