Shanghai:

This lively metropolis in China offers something for everyone. Visit the Reclining Buddha, see the European-style buildings along the Bund, wonder at the exotic

temples, sample the art of jade and ivory carving in a workshop or take a train to Wuxi for a ride on the Grand Canal

Okinawa: is a subtropical paradise where flowers bloom the year-round and the emerald-green sea is full of beautiful coral reefs. Step back in time while visiting Shuriyjo Castle, or enjoy Ryukyu Kingdom, a 17th century theme park and setting for a popular Japanese tv show. Take a tour of the Gyokusendo stalactite cave, with more than 900,000 stalactites, stalagmites and pillars.

The success of **Hong Kong** is evident in its impressive skyline, which appears to jut straight from the sea. Parts of the city, including the houseboat district of Aberdeen, actually are afloat. The best views are from Victoria Peak, and the best souvenirs at Stanley Market. Excursions also take tourists across the South China Sea to Macau to visit the Guia Lighthouse, the Temple of the Buddhist Goddess of Mercy and a casino for a chance at the tables.

The atmosphere of **Ho Chi Minh City**, also known as the "Pearl of the Orient," is warm and energetic. Tourists usually choose to wander the busy streets of the Chinatown district, experience the Vietnamese art of water puppetry or visit the Reunification Hall. Other highlights are the former American Embassy, the Rex Hotel and the War Museum.

The diverse roots of this **Singapore** are reflected in its ethnic neighborhoods. Tourists are presented with a mix of high-rises in the city, tea houses in Chinatown, mansions in the colonial district, Victorian-style government buildings, Hindu temples and Arabian bazaars. Most shore excursions here are half-day tours with stops in the Little India area and at the Museum at Empress Place. An excursion to Jurong Bird Park for a walk through the aviaries is also a good choice.
