Coldfoot's far north location places it one of the world's best aurora viewing areas.

Accommodations: Located halfway between Fairbanks and Prudhoe Bay, Coldfoot Camp provides an excellent base for travelers in Alaska's Brooks Mountain Range. Although rustic by urban standards, Coldfoot Camp is clean and each room features two twin beds and private bath facilities in each of the rooms, a luxury in the remote wilderness of Alaska's Arctic.

Below is the itinerary for the Escorted Northern Lights Tour.

DAY **1** Fairbanks Arrival

Arrive into Fairbanks at any time. Transfer to your hotel via hotel courtesy shuttle or on your own. Overnight in Fairbanks.

DAY **2** Fairbanks to Coldfoot Camp

This morning, transfer to the Fairbanks Airport via hotel courtesy shuttle or on your own. From here, you will depart on a guided ground tour in a comfortable tour van. Travel through Alaska's interior on the famed Dalton Highway, past old mining towns and over the Yukon River. Along the way, your driver/guide will explain the natural and cultural history of Alaska's Arctic. View the amazing Trans-Alaska Pipeline and learn about this engineering marvel. You will cross the Arctic Circle in ceremonious fashion and receive an official Arctic Circle Certificate. In the early evening, arrive in Coldfoot in time to relax on your own, or with an optional Aurora Borealis viewing tour to nearby Wiseman. Overnight at Coldfoot Camp, basic accommodations with private bathroom.

**DAY
3 Coldfoot Camp**

Spend time experiencing Alaska's Arctic with a variety of optional tours, such as an excursion further north into to the Brooks Mountain Range along the Dalton Highway, dog sledding with a local musher, or Aurora viewing in Wiseman (not included). Overnight at Coldfoot Camp.

**DAY
4 Coldfoot Camp to Fairbanks**

Depart Coldfoot on a scenic small plane flight to Fairbanks. This tour can also operate in reverse with a flight to Coldfoot on Day 2 and a driving tour to Fairbanks today. Upon arrival in Fairbanks, transfer to your hotel by shuttle. Overnight in Fairbanks.
