Monday, September 10	Mt. McKinley, AK / Denali, AK This morning is free to relax or opt for an excursion. Witness the majestic scenery en route to your next stop, the Denali Princess Wilderness Lodge - set above the Nenana River Canyon with a dramatic main lodge. Once settled in, visit the tour desk to help you choose from an array of excursions.		
Tuesday, September 11	Denali National Park, AK You have a full day to get out into one of America's best national parks. This morning, a Natural History Tour serves as a wonderful introduction to the animals, plants and geological features found there. Later today, you may want to stop by the tour desk to plan an activity such as rafting or hiking.		
Wednesday, September 12	Denali National Park, AK / Whittier, AK Enjoy the scenic rail journey through some of the best wilderness in the Great Land on the Direct-to-the-Wilderness rail service. Once in Whittier, you'll step from the train onto your ship for the beginning of your unforgettable cruise.

19 Sept (Arrive Vancouver and overnight for 3 nights at the Rosedale on Robson)

20 & 22 Sept: Free days Vancouver

Vancouver, a bustling west coast seaport in British Columbia, is among Canada's densest, most ethnically diverse cities. A popular filming location, it's surrounded by mountains, and also has thriving art, theatre and music scenes. Vancouver Art Gallery is known for its works by regional artists, while the Museum of Anthropology houses preeminent First Nations collections.

22 Sept (Vancouver to Kamloops – by Rocky Mountaineer Rail)

*(Departs: 7:30 am, Arrives: 5:35 pm)**

Travel aboard the Rocky Mountaineer from the coastal city of Vancouver to the interior's largest city, Kamloops. On today's journey, you will see dramatic changes in scenery from the lush green fields of the Fraser River Valley, through forests and winding river canyons surrounded by the peaks of the Coastal Mountains, to the desert-like environment of the interior. Highlights include the rushing waters of Hell's

Gate in Fraser Canyon and the steep slopes and snow sheds along the Thompson River. Your day concludes as the Rocky Mountaineer travels along the shores of Kamloops Lake and into your overnight destination, Kamloops. **[B] [L]**

23 Sept (Kamloops to Jasper – by Rocky Mountaineer Rail)

*(Departs: 8:10 am, Arrives: 6:10 pm)**

Your journey continues north and east to the mighty Canadian Rockies and the province of Alberta. Once again you will be surrounded by dramatic scenery as you follow the banks of the North Thompson River through the Monashee and Cariboo Mountains, climbing ever nearer to the high peaks of the Continental Divide. Today's highlights include Mount Robson, the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies at 3,954 metres (12,972 feet), Pyramid Falls, as well as the climb over Yellowhead Pass into Jasper National Park. Your rail journey ends upon arrival in the town of Jasper this evening. Overnight in Jasper. **[B] [L]**



24 Sept (Jasper to Banff – by Coach)

*(Departs: 8:30 am, Arrives: 7:30 pm)**

Start the morning with a refreshing hike in Maligne Canyon, one of the world's largest and deepest limestone gorges criss-crossed by 6 narrow bridges. Then head south on the Icefields Parkway to experience the thundering waters of Athabasca Falls, picturesque Peyto Lake, and majestic Castle Mountain. At the Columbia Icefield, ride the "Ice Explorer" on Athabasca Glacier or visit the Glacier Skywalk! Overnight in Banff. **[B]**

25 Sept (Banff National Park – by Coach)

*(Departs: 8:00 am, Arrives: 6:00 pm)**

Enjoy scenic views, including the spectacular Lower Falls, as you walk through Johnston Canyon. At Lake Louise, stroll the shores of the glacier-fed lake and enjoy the atmosphere of the world-famous Chateau

Lake Louise. Afternoon highlights include Moraine Lake, the Banff Springs Hotel, the Upper Hot Springs**, and views from the top of Sulphur Mountain**. Overnight in Lake Louise. [B]

Tour Variations for Day 4:

1. Extend your stay in Lake Louise. Additional accommodation in Lake Louise can be arranged at additional cost. Flexible departure to Calgary.
2. Return to Vancouver on the Rocky Mountaineer or fly to your next destination from Calgary.

Motorcoach transfer from Lake Louise to Calgary. Enjoy free time in the heart of downtown Calgary. [B]
Fly to New York and arrival transfer and overnight Washington Jefferson hotel for 2 nights.

Fabulous views from the Lotus Spa complement massage therapy, fitness classes or visits to the sauna. Take your choice of poolside environments: near the spa, on the Lido Deck near a bar and pizzeria or at the splash pool on the Sports Deck. Adults can also relax at the Sanctuary, an adults-only retreat. Younger passengers have their own pool in the child and teen recreation area. The Adventure of the Seas offers just about every imaginable amenity at sea. Enjoy ice skating and professional shows at a skating rink that doubles as a venue for concerts, game shows and other productions. Or you can in-line skate on a track that swerves around the 13th deck. There's the nine-hole Adventure Dunes miniature golf course and the Royal Promenade, a bustling "street" of shops, restaurants and bars that's overlooked by four decks of interior staterooms. You can even climb a rock wall that looms 200 feet above sea level. Couples can take romance to new heights at the Skylight Chapel, located at the tallest point on the ship. A variety of themed bars and lounges, dance clubs (separate facilities for teens and adults) and the La Marquis theater offer nighttime diversions. Rising three levels is the Gotham Dining Room,

where you'll enjoy Continental fare. For dining alternatives, head to Johnny Rocket's, a '50s-style diner, the Island Grille or one of the spots on the Royal Promenade. Club Ocean is the social center for younger guests, and teens have their own hangouts, too.
