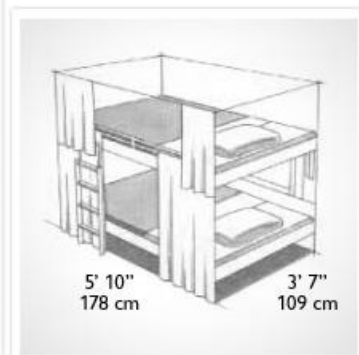
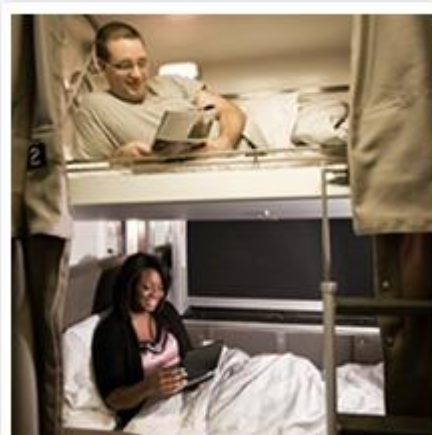

  - - Room from mattress to partition is 5 in. = 12.7 cm
  - - Foot end of mattress has radius 10 in. = 25.4 cm
- Public washroom facilities in same car
- Access to shower facilities
- **Daytime:** one wide couch-style seat facing another seat (other berth's seat)
- **Night-time:** folds out into bed at night, with heavy curtains for privacy
- Use of a ladder at night to reach the bed

#### **Day 9: Vancouver to Jasper.**

**Day 11: Sightseeing in Banff National Park**
