**DAY 2 Arrive Stockholm, Sweden**

Arrive Stockholm Transfer by taxi or catch airport train to your hotel. Overnight Rex Hotel, Stockholm for 2 nights. The remainder of the day is free to explore Stockholm at leisure.

**DAY 3 Stockholm Day Tour**

See Stockholm and its surrounding areas by land, sitting in a comfortable, air-conditioned coach and listening in your own language. Afterwards our staff will then join to the boat that is waiting to take you out to sea – and from the water you will see a picturesque Stockholm, at its most spectacular.

**DAY 4 Arrive Reykavik, Iceland**

Fly from Stockholm to Reykjavik, Iceland, one of the most beautiful places in the world. Transfer to your 5-nights hotel accommodation

in the heart of town. The remainder of the day is free for you to explore Reykjavik at leisure.

### **Day 5 The Golden Circle**

The Gullfoss and Geysir bus tour takes you on a day trip to see the world-famous Geysir geothermal area and Gullfoss, the queen of Icelandic waterfalls, as well as Thingvellir National Park. The Geysir geothermal area boasts spouting springs, including Strokkur, the most active geyser in Iceland. At Gullfoss you are given the opportunity to stand next to the amazing waterfall, watching enormous quantities of water tumble violently into a deep, meandering gorge. Whether you take the morning or the afternoon tour, you will spend your time encountering a cross-section of Iceland's natural wonders and geological phenomena at Thingvellir National Park, an area of historical and geological significance.



### **Day 6 Northern Lights by Boat**

Today is a free day during the day to explore Iceland at leisure. This evening we will go hunting the northern lights from the ocean is an amazing experience; sailing away from the coastline of Reykjavik and seeing the aurora borealis out on the North-Atlantic ocean with beautiful mountains and the city lights in the background is something you won't forget. During the tour our expert guide will tell you all about the northern lights, the folklore and superstition, as well as explaining the underlying scientific facts that make this magical light show possible. The tour takes 2 – 3 hours, departing from Reykjavik's old harbour; viewing the beautiful coastline of the capital and the city lights on the way out to search for the lights. In only 15-30 minutes we will be on a prime location for viewing the auroras. Included are warm overalls since it does get chilly in the winter and usually much of the time is spent outside gazing at the night sky. We have a cozy and warm seating area inside the boat

and we are dedicated to making the trip an enjoyable experience for everyone, therefore it is subject to the right weather conditions. When the northern lights forecast looks good - but it is too windy to go out on sea - we will still take our customers out for a northern lights tour on a bus, and they will also get to go out on the boat as well next available day. Hot beverages & special Icelandic treats are sold on board.

### **Days 7 & 8 Free days Iceland**

The next two days free days to explore Iceland at leisure.
