Tour itinerary:

Day 1– Cairo

Upon arrival in Cairo, you will be met by our travel representative in Egypt and transferred to your hotel for overnight.

Day 2– Cairo Touring. This private tour of the Egypt Museum, Alabaster Mosque and Khan el-Khalil is perfect for travelers who are eager to explore greater Cairo. Follow an expert guide on a tour through some of the city's other great highlights and learn more about the history and religion that make this destination truly unique. Private tour to three of central Cairo's most famous sites - Egyptian Museum, Alabaster Mosque and Khan el-Khalili See the famous treasures of King Tutankhamun at the Egyptian Museum Learn about the Islamic faith at the beautiful Alabaster Mosque Shop for bargains at Khan el-Khalili bazaar Fantastic views of the city skyline at the Citadel of Salah el-Din Enjoy privileged, personalized attention from your expert Egyptologist guide on this special private tour

Day 3 –Cairo (Pyramids, Museum)

After breakfast your private Egyptologist tour guide and driver will pick you up and start your tour. Drive to Giza and visit the Pyramids. See the Great Pyramid, a royal burial chamber and the Sphinx. Lunch en route. This afternoon enjoy a second visit the Egyptian Museum; this houses a magnificent collection of Pharaonic antiquities, especially the golden treasures of Tut Ankh Amun. Return to hotel for overnight (B,L)

Day 4 –Cairo/ Alexandria

After breakfast, transfer to Alexandria visit the Catacomb, the pompi pillar, Library of Alexandria, lunch en route, transfer to your hotel in Alexandria, overnight at hotel. (B,L)

Day 5 – Alexandria/ Cairo

Breakfast, visit Qaitbay Citadel and Montazah Gardens, return back to Cairo, lunch en route, overnight at your hotel in Cairo. (B,L)

Day 6 – Luxor (Karnak & Luxor Temple)

Breakfast at hotel, transfer to Cairo airport for your flight to Luxor. Upon arrival to Luxor, our representative will pick up you for embarkation on your Nile Cruise. visit the great Luxor Temple and the magnificent Karnak Temple of Amun with its famous Hypostyle Hall and the 134 huge columns, the Statue of Ramses II, the Obelisk of Queen Hatshepsut and the Sacred Lake. Overnight in Luxor (B, L, D)

Day 7 – Luxor (West Bank)

In the morning your sightseeing in Luxor includes the West Bank (Thebes) where some of the richest treasures in the world exists, including the Tomb of Tut Ankh

Amun (optional) and other royal tombs including Ramses VI in the Valley of the Kings, you will be able to visit some of these tombs, Visit Hatshepsut funerary temple at Dier El Bahari and the Colossi of Memnon. Then transfer back to your Cruise for lunch. In the afternoon you will sail through the locks of Esna to Edfu and dinner on board and Overnight. (B, L, D)

Day 8 – (Edfu & Kom-Ombo)

In the morning, Sail to Edfu, visit Edfu temple, than sail to Kom Ombo, where you will visit the Sobek Temple, dedicated to the two gods, which offers beautiful murals and reliefs. Sail to Aswan and Overnight (B, L, D)

Day 9 - (High Dam, Philae temple, Felucca)

After breakfast you will visit the High Dam, and Philae Temple. In the afternoon you will sail on an Egyptian felucca around Elephantine Island and the Botanical Gardens on Kitchener Island and the Agha Khan Mausoleum. Overnight in Aswan (B, L, D)

Day 10 - Aswan – Abu Simbel - See the ancient marvel of Abu Simbel on a private day trip from Aswan. Journey southward by private, air-conditioned vehicle as your personal guide shares tales of the 3,400-year-old complex, a masterwork of ancient Egyptian engineering beside Lake Nasser. Awe at the two temples, graced by colossi of Ramses II and his wife Nefertari, and tour the Great Temple's statue-lined halls and battle reliefs. While you explore, hear the incredible story of the temples' 1960s relocation to protect them from flooding after the building of the Aswan High Dam. Private day trip by road from Aswan to Abu Simbel, with private air-conditioned transport Venture south to the cliff-cut UNESCO-listed complex, overlooking Lake Nasser Learn about the history of the two temples, built by Ramses II in the 13th century BC Ogle the gigantic colossi of Ramses II and Nefertari at the temple gateways Admire the statues and engraved battle scenes inside the Great Temple Hear how the temples were relocated in the 1960s to protect them from rising Lake Nasser Enjoy in-depth attention and personalized commentary from a private Egyptologist guide. Box Breakfast, Lunch, dinner on board. (B,L,D)

Day 11 - Aswan / Kom Ombo/ Edfu

After breakfast, sail to Kom Ombo, sail to Edu. Overnight in Edfu (B, L, D)

Day 12 - Edfu/Esna/ Luxor

Breakfast, sail to Esna. P.m sail to Luxor, dinner and overnight on board (B, L, D)

Day 13 - Luxor HABU Temple

After breakfast, disembarkation from the ship, transfer to Luxor Hotel. This afternoon Visit Habu Temple, the Valley of the Artisans, and Valley of the Queens on private tour of Luxor's West Bank that explores fascinating ancient art and architecture. With a personal guide to lead the way, you'll learn the stories behind the vivid paintings at Habu Temple, as well as tombs built for both workers and royalty. Since this tour includes all entrance fees, round-trip transport from your hotel, water, and snacks, it's a hassle-free way to experience Luxor's West Bank, the site of ancient Thebes.

Day 14 - Luxor / Cairo

Check out of hotel and transfer to Luxor airport for your flight back to Cairo, then transfer for your international departure to Australia.

Payment in full must be made no less than 90 days before travel, unless required earlier by any supplier.

PRICES
