Visit: Zagreb, Plitvice, Trilj, Dubrovnik, Split, Trogir, Zadar, Zagreb

Day 1 Depart Australia

Day 2 (Wednesday): Zagreb – Arrival

Upon arrival at Zagreb Airport, you will be transferred to the hotel. Meet your tour guide. Have Dinner and enjoy your first night.

Day 3 (Thursday): Zagreb - Plitvice

Morning city tour of Zagreb, including the fortified Upper Town, the city's historical centre, St. Mark's Church with its multicoloured roof, the Cathedral, the Croatian National Theatre and the University. Afternoon departure for Plitvice, dinner and overnight.

Day 4 (Friday): Plitvice

After breakfast, we tour the Plitvice Lakes National Park on the UNESCO's List of World Natural Heritage. Sixteen lakes, each at a different level, are joined in a series of cascading waterfalls. Surrounded by dense wood, Plitvice Lakes are a natural phenomenon of a rare and unique beauty. Dinner and overnight in Plitvice region.

Morning departure for Dubrovnik. Dinner and overnight stay in Dubrovnik.
