The next three days are free days in Barcelona to explore at leisure. Barcelona, the cosmopolitan capital of Spain's Catalonia region, is known for its art and architecture. The fantastical Sagrada Família church and other modernist landmarks designed by Antoni Gaudí dot the city. Museu Picasso and Fundació Joan Miró feature modern art by their namesakes. City history museum MUHBA, includes several Roman archaeological sites.

Day 6: Free days Barcelona.

DAY 15, Tuesday - Train from Barcelona to Madrid

Today's tour of Madrid's impressive architecture begins at the Plaza de Cibeles with its striking buildings. Continue to view the magnificent Royal Palace, Europe's second largest, and to the Plaza de España dominated by the monument to Cervantes, famed author of Don Quixote. The rest of the day is yours to explore on your own. Or, participate in the *optional* tour to El Escorial, the stunning combination monastery-palace-mausoleum built by Philip II

DAY 17, Thursday - Toledo City Tour, Travel to Granada

Travel to nearby Toledo, the former capital city of Spain that still retains its medieval atmosphere and charm. Recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1986, Toledo is known for its extensive monumental heritage and historical coexistence of Christian, Muslim and Jewish cultures. Take a panoramic drive along the Tagus River and enjoy views of the Alcazar of Toledo. Walk through the ancient Jewish Quarter before visiting the Santa Maria la Blanca Synagogue, the oldest synagogue in Europe still standing. Next, visit St. Tome Church, with its magnificent masterpiece by El Greco. Then, drive across the arid landscapes of Don Quixote's "La Mancha" to Granada in Andalusia for dinner and overnight

DAY 18, Friday - Moorish Influenced Alhambra, Seville

Today's sightseeing of Moorish Granada is highlighted by a visit to the 13th century Alhambra,* one of Spain's most celebrated monuments, dramatically perched atop Assabica Hill and overlooking the entire city. This imposing hilltop fortress, declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is one of the world's finest examples of Moorish art and architecture. During the reign of the Moors, the Alhambra served as the residence of the royal family. See spectacular views of the town and the Sierra Nevada Mountains before continuing to Seville, capital of Andalusia for overnight

**Alhambra visiting times, which may include evening hours, and which areas of the complex are accessible on the day of your visit, are determined solely at the discretion of the Alhambra. Your itinerary will be arranged by your Tour Manager to accommodate the designated time of entry.*

DAY 19, Saturday - Seville City Tour

On this morning's visit in Seville, admire the beautiful Plaza de España and the Maria Luisa Park by the Guadalquivir River. Explore the narrow streets and the many beautiful plazas of the quaint old Santa Cruz Quarter. Remainder of the day is at leisure in the bustling downtown area to discover this vibrant city on your own. Tonight, enjoy an *optional* Flamenco Show performed by some of Seville's leading Flamenco artists

DAY 20, Sunday - Cordoba City Tour, Madrid

Depart Seville to Cordoba, founded by the Romans. The most famous site in the city is the Mezquita de Cordoba, once the largest mosque in the world that was transformed into a cathedral in the 16th century. The walking tour of the city includes the ancient Jewish Quarter, with its labyrinth of winding narrow streets and picturesque squares. The medieval synagogue on Calle de los Judios is one of only three originals still remaining in Spain. After lunch on your own, travel to Madrid for overnight. Tonight, enjoy a Farewell Dinner together

MSC Preziosa Overview

In April 2019 MSC Preziosa departs the Caribbean, crossing the Atlantic to Hamburg. On the way visit 12 ports, and note that the fare is very low. From Hamburg and other ports MSC Preziosa makes a number of cruises to Arctic Norway and Iceland, the Iberian Peninsula, the Baltic, and the Continental coast. All these are excellent value and offer great sight-seeing. From September to November 2019 9-night cruises cover the western Mediterranean. After that MSC Preziosa returns to the Caribbean, taking on guests in the French overseas regions of Martinique and Basse-Terre. MSC Line offers good affordable cruise vacations the Italian Way, filled with fun activities and having a wide appeal.

Accommodation

Of her 1,751 cabins, 80% have an ocean view, and as many have private balconies they are quite affordable. All cabins have single beds that can be converted into a double bed, air conditioning, bathroom with shower, interactive television, radio, telephone, internet connection (for a fee), minibar, and safe. Super family cabins sleep up to six people and comprise of two connecting triple cabins, two bathrooms and two balconies. All cabins and staterooms are modern, comfortable and very stylish. For all cabins continental breakfast is complimentary from 7.30 to 10 am, while room service snacks can be bought at other times. For suites a basket of fruit is provided at embarkation, and replenished daily.

Food and Dining

There are four main dining areas. The two-deck Il Cherchio d'Oro is set-table set-time venue with Mediterranean cuisine and always-available "slow food" – spaghetti, chicken breast, salmon fillets and vegetable of the day. Instead of paying for cold water in dining rooms, fill your own bottle in your cabin, chill it in the mini-bar, and bring it with you at meal times. For breakfast and lunch there is free seating, though be prepared to sit with guests using another language. The alternative restaurant Red Velvet is also traditional. For a ship of this size food outlets can be found

everywhere. Casual breakfasts and lunches are available in a large self-serve buffet eatery. Sit and watch fellow passengers pass by at Il Cappuccino Coffee Bar with its coffees, teas and chocolates.

Entertainment

L'Avanguardia is a state-of-the-art 1600 seat venue and its twice-nightly productions have received high acclaim. Some productions may be short, just 30 minutes. Catch a movie in the 4D Cinema. Dance late at Club 33 Disco or have fun at the Casinò della Palme. For the young set there's the Graffiti Disco Teen and the video games room Virtual World.
