Diamond Princess Overview

Diamond Princess itineraries centre for most of the year around Japan, Taiwan and South Korea. Visit a number of major ports: Kobe, Yokohama, Nagoya, Osaka, Taipei, and occasionally ports in China, a Russian island, and Vietnam. Cruises range from 3 to 32 nights. For the best selection of Japanese cruises, Diamond Princess would be hard to beat. A feature is sailing the beautiful Inland Sea of Japan. The cruises around Japan show off cherry blossoms in season, the Inland Sea, engineering marvels, ancient castles, historic gardens, and magnificent mountain scenery. In December 2020 there's a special 28-night tour out of Yokohama that visits China (2 ports), Hong Kong, Vietnam (2 ports), Singapore, Brunei, Malaysia, the Philippines and Taiwan. Princess Cruises organises on-shore tours that can be booked before sailing or during the cruise. For some voyages pre- and post-cruises tours are available to extend your stay in major ports.

Accommodation

There are six types of cabin and 35 price categories: insides, outsides (some obstructed), balcony cabins, outside mini-suites (with and without balconies) and balcony suites. Cabins are roomy and nicely appointed, with satellite TV access to major channels. Standard cabins are practical and attractive, many have additional upper berths for children, and some have inter-connecting doors. The larger the stateroom, the more additional facilities. All guests receive turndown service, chocolates on pillow at night, bathrobes and amenity kits, and complimentary room service on most items 24 hours a day. There are no single cabins, 28 wheelchair-accessible cabins, and some cabins accommodate families of three and four.

Food and Dining

Traditional dining in the International Dining Room offers you a pre-selection of one of two seating times throughout the cruise. Anytime Dining (sitting when and with whom you choose) is offered in the four other dining rooms. All serve five course meals changed daily, with chefs inducted into the prestigious Chaîne des Rôtisseurs gastronomic society. Sabatini's serves Italian cuisine, Sterling Steakhouse serves steak and seafood, and there's Kai Sushi (all for

an extra cover charge). Dress code is smart casual, and on cruises longer than three days dress for a formal night for every week of sailing. Breakfast and lunch are provided in an open seating arrangement. (Of course a continental breakfast can be delivered to your stateroom, and there is a stateroom menu.) Passengers booked in cabins with balconies can order several special, romantic meals to be served restaurant-style on the verandah - Ultimate Balcony Dining. Order special dietary requests before sailing.

Entertainment

As for entertainment, there is more than can be squeezed into a week. The Princess Theatre is two decks high, featuring glamorous production shows every second or third evening. The Vista Show Lounge with its three stages presents cabaret, and doubles for lectures, bingo and horse-racing during the day. Explorer's Lounge hosts cabaret acts and dance bands. Movies first-run feature films pool-side at Under the Stars on Sun Deck. There are 12 bars and lounges with live music and dancing. A new feature is the new three-deck-high street-cafe-style Piazza, for sipping coffee and watching the occasional passing performer. Stroll around and shop duty-free, or check your email at the Internet Café.

MSC Splendida Overview

MSC Splendida is a world traveller. Until mid-February 2020 the ship is in the Far East, then returns from Shanghai to Hamburg over 54 nights via the Suez Canal. The itinerary stays overnight at Dubai, Bangkok and Hong Kong, and visits many ports missed by other cruise ships. For four months Splendida sails out of Kiel (Germany) to the Baltic ports and southern Norway. Later in the year she cruises the western Mediterranean. In mid-November 2020 the ship crosses the Pacific to sail the eastern and southern Caribbean from the island ports of Martinique and Basse-Terre. Choose either of two 7-night itineraries, or join them for 14 nights. You'll visit a port a day and visit a dozen islands.

Accommodation

Of her 1,637 cabins, 80% have an ocean view, and as many have private balconies they are quite affordable. All cabins have single beds that can be converted into a double bed, air conditioning, bathroom with shower, interactive television, radio, telephone, internet connection (for a fee), minibar, and safe. The two-deck La Reggia Restaurant is set-table set-time venue with Mediterranean cuisine and always-available “slow food” – spaghetti, chicken breast, salmon fillets and vegetable of the day. Instead of paying for cold water in dining rooms, fill your own bottle in your cabin, chill it in the mini-bar, and bring it with you at meal times. For breakfast and lunch there is free seating, though be prepared to sit with guests using another language. The alternative restaurant Villa Verde Restaurant is also traditional, offering an assorted Mediterranean menu, including light choices and options that are always available. The ship's L'Olivo, an a la carte speciality restaurant, provides food from 14 countries located in the Mediterranean region. For spicy Mexican cuisine Tex Mex Santa Fe is the right choice. The full-view kitchen completes the traditional atmosphere of this restaurant. All the alternative dining venues charge on an à la carte basis at reasonable prices.

Entertainment

The Strand Theatre is a state-of-the-art 1600 seat venue and its twice-nightly productions have received high acclaim. Some productions may be short, just 30 minutes. Catch a movie in the 4D Cinema. Dance late at Club 33 Disco or have fun at the Royal Palm Casino. For the young set there's the Graffiti Disco Teen and the video games room Virtual World.

MSC Fantasia Overview

MSC Fantasia is one of the world's Top 10 Large Resort Ships (Berlitz 2018). From April to October each year MSCV Fantasia offers 7-night cruises of the Western Mediterranean. Join the ship at any port on the circular route. From December through to February MSC Fantasia sails the coasts of Brazil and Uruguay over 3 to 8 nights, mostly out of Rio de Janeiro. So brush up on your Portuguese and Spanish. Around November and March annually MSC Fantasia crosses the Atlantic, so consider visiting two continents and take an inexpensive and relaxing ocean crossing. MSC offers good affordable cruise vacations the Italian Way, filled with fun activities and having a wide appeal. MSC Cruises are family orientated, and children are very much catered for, filling the ship in school holidays. Children sail free on certain itineraries, sharing a cabin with two adults. Note that port calls may be short time-wise.
