## ***ITINERARY***

Visit: Dubrovnik, Mostar, Sarajevo, Belgrade, Zagreb, Plitvice, Trojir, Split, Brač, Makarska, Korčula, Dubrovnik, Mljet, Hvar, Split

**Day 1: Depart Australia.**

**Day 2 (Sunday): Arrival in Dubrovnik**

Upon arrival at Dubrovnik Airport, transfer to the hotel. Meet the tour guide, dinner and overnight stay.

Meals: Dinner

**Day 3 (Monday): Dubrovnik - Mostar - Sarajevo**

After breakfast, depart for Mostar. On arrival you'll enjoy a sightseeing tour of the Old City of Mostar, recently included in the UNESCO's List of World Cultural Heritage. We will tour its elegant Bridge, Old Bazaar, the Mosque and a typical Turkish house. Then continue to Sarajevo where you'll have an afternoon city tour of Sarajevo, including Baščaršija and Gazi Husref Bey Mosque. Dinner and overnight in Sarajevo.

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

**Day 4 (Tuesday): Sarajevo - Belgrade**

This morning we drive northwards to Belgrade, with a stop on the way for lunch. Continue to Belgrade for dinner and your overnight stay.

**Day 5 (Wednesday): Belgrade - Zagreb**

In the morning enjoy a sightseeing tour of Belgrade. The tour includes a visit to the imposing Kalemegdan Fortress, dramatically set at the confluence of the Sava and Danube Rivers. You'll also see Republic Square and Knez Mihajlova Street, Saint Sava Temple, the largest Orthodox Church in the city, and Tito's Memorial. Then we continue our journey to Zagreb for dinner and our overnight stay.

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

**Day 6 (Thursday): Zagreb - Plitvice National Park**

After breakfast we have a morning city tour of Zagreb, including the fortified Upper Town, the city's historical centre, St. Mark's Church with its multicolored roof, the Cathedral, the Croatian National Theatre and the University. After the city tour, we will drive to Plitvice Lakes, listed on the UNESCO's List of World Natural Heritage. Sixteen lakes, each at the

different levels, are joined in a series of cascading waterfalls. Surrounded by dense wood Plitvice Lakes is a natural phenomenon of rare and unique beauty. Dinner and overnight stay in the Plitvice region.

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

#### Day 7 (Friday): Plitvice - Trogir - Split

Morning departure for Trogir where we will visit the Cathedral of St. Lawrence before continuing to Split. On arrival enjoy a city tour of Split, including the Diocletian's Palace, listed on the UNESCO's List of World Cultural Heritage with the Peristyle, the Jupiter's Temple and the Cathedral. Dinner and overnight stay in Split.

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

#### Day 8 (Saturday): Split - Embarkation

After breakfast, we embark in Split, with a welcome reception followed by a dinner that evening. Overnight onboard.

#### Day 9 (Sunday): Brač - Makarska

In the morning we set sail for the island of Brač. Enjoy a pleasant sea-front walk and swim, if weather permits, in Pučišća, in one of Brač's many lovely coves and bays, where you can visit the amazing stonemason school. Lunch on board. Our next destination is Makarska on the mainland, where we will spend the night. You will have the opportunity to book the Wine Tasting excursion where you'll enjoy and learn about traditional Dalmatian wines.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

#### Day 10 (Monday): Makarska - Korčula

We depart for the island of Korčula in the morning, with a stop along the way to swim and relax, if weather permits. Enjoy lunch on board. In the late afternoon we arrive at Korčula, the most preserved medieval town whose street design is based on a fish bone pattern, to spend the night. You will have the opportunity to book a walking tour of Korčula.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

#### Day 11 (Tuesday): Korčula - Dubrovnik

In the morning we start sailing to Dubrovnik, stopping on the way for a swim, if weather permits. Lunch is on board, and in the afternoon we arrive in UNESCO World Heritage listed Dubrovnik – "Pearl of the

Adriatic". You will have the possibility to book walking tour of Dubrovnik with transfer included. We will spend the night in Dubrovnik.

#### Day 12 (Wednesday): Dubrovnik - Mljet National Park

Departing from Dubrovnik in the morning, our sail to Mljet Island includes a stop for swimming, if weather permits, and lunch on board. Croatia's "Greenest Island" will hypnotize you with its beautiful, untouched nature and its cultural heritage. We arrive in the heart of the National Park. If you want to visit it, you'll just walk to the entrance where you can purchase the ticket to walk around the Great Lake and the Small Lake and join the boat ride to St. Mary Island. This evening enjoy the Captain's dinner onboard. We will spend the night in Mljet.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

#### Day 13 (Thursday): Mljet - Hvar

In the morning we continue our adventure by sailing to the island of Hvar. We stop along the way for a relaxing swim in one of the secluded coves (weather permitting). Lunch is on board and in the afternoon we arrive in the town of Hvar. Apart from its unique cultural heritage, Hvar is a celebrated destination for singles and families, sailboats and super-yachts. With its sunny climate, natural beauty, excellent food, wine and sports, Hvar has it all, which is why it is one of the most popular destinations in summer time. While in Hvar you will have the opportunity to book a guided tour of Hvar. You'll be able to enjoy the evening here.

Note: Due to the limited capacity of the Hvar harbor (during peak season in July and August) port of call can be substituted for Stari Grad/Jelsa. In that case transfer by bus will be organized to and from Hvar.

#### Day 14 (Friday): Hvar - Split

In the morning we depart for Split, stopping along the way for a relaxing swim at Bobovišća bay on Brač Island, if weather permits. After lunch on board we arrive in Split, the historical centre of the city is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Overnight in Split.

#### Day 15 (Saturday): Split - Disembark

After breakfast, disembark & transfer to Split Airport for flights to Australia.

#### **DEPOSIT**

A deposit is required to confirm your booking (varies depending on package booked). Receipt of deposit will be taken as an understanding by Destination International Holidays that the customer has checked their confirmed travel arrangements and has read and agreed to the terms and conditions.

#### **FINAL PAYMENT**

Payment in full must be made no less than 120 days before travel, unless required earlier by any supplier.

**PRICES**

All prices for our tours are advised in Australian Dollars (\$AUD). They are based on airfares, schedules and tariffs at the time of printing. Destination International Holidays reserves the right to vary the cost of the tour, taxes and airline prices if necessary by reason of currency fluctuation, cost increase, or airfare increase. All prices are subject to confirmation from local tour operators. Once full payment has been received by Destination International no surcharges in respect to currency fluctuations will be applied.
